

Iowa Arboretum Spring Fever III

Plants for Sale

Magnolias

All grown on own roots. (height X width at 10 years)

1. **M. x 'Butterflies' PP7456** Zone 4 (12-15' X 6') Phil Savage's lovely and hardy Magnolia hybrid produces an abundance of yellow spring blossoms that perch like butterflies on its branches. These blooms appear before the leaves and are one of the thrills of spring. Matures to a large specimen with time.
2. **M. x 'Elegant Spring'** Zone 4 (12-15' X 8') Stylish, elegant ivory blossoms with inner hints of soft pink. Very appealing classic, fragrant flowers with 24 tepals. Parent plant bloomed very well at 5'-6' with about 50 flowers. Parentage is M. 'Leonard Messel' x M. 'White Rose'.
3. **M. x 'Roseanne'** Zone 4 (12-15' X 6') Sweetly fragrant blooms are rich lavender pink with soft pink insides. The 6-8 tepals are broad and remain upright. Semi-glossy foliage with rugose texture. Parentage is M. 'O'Neill' x M. 'Norman Gold'. Hybridized by Dennis Ledvina.
4. **M. 'Royal Tapestry'** Zone 4 (12-15' X 6') Large, pointed buds with 6 tepals which open to an unusual, beautiful tapestry blend of reddish purple and greenish purple increasing towards its base. Slightly fragrant. Upright form. Very hardy. Blooms late in season. Parentage M. 'Woodsmen' x M. 'Pink Surprise'.
5. **M. 'Spring Royalty'** Zone 5 (15-18' X 8-10') Strongly fragrant flowers of deep royal purple-red with an ivory-white interior emerge before the foliage. Blooms at a young age with gracefully elongated flowers consisting of 6 tepals. Spring blooms are well distributed over the entire upright specimen. A Dennis Ledvina selection (M. 'Holland Red' x M. 'White Rose').
6. **M. 'Wedding Vows'** Zone 4 (16' X 8') (M. 'Woodsmen' x M. 'Big Dude') Refined and graceful large ivory white blossoms that are uniquely interesting with long tepals that gently trail like a wedding dress train.

Peonies

Herbaceous, all Zone 3

1. **'Coral Supreme'** Wissing/Klehm, 1981. Salmon-coral, semidouble, early, 36"
2. **'Crinkled Linens'** Roy Klehm, 1998. White, single, 32"
3. **'Early Scout'** Auten, 1952. Dark red, single, dissected leaves, 24" APS Gold Medal 2001
4. **'Loves Touch'** Krekler/Klehm, 1999. Soft pink, semidouble to double, mid to late, 26"
5. **'Margaret Clark'** Mains, 1956. Dark pink, double, late, 34"
6. **'Scarlet O'Hara'** Falk/Glasscock, 1956. Red, single, early, 36", excellent foliage

Tree, Zone 4

7. **'Ariadne'** Nassos Daphnis. Alluring peach semi-double with rose red edging. Inner petals are ruffled; outer petals are round and well-formed. Fragrant with good stem strength and substance. Midseason.

Intersectional (also known as Itoh) Peonies, Zone 4 Excellent Landscape Peonies

8. **'Garden Treasure'** Don Hollingsworth, 1984. Yellow, semi-double to double with red center, Mid to late season. APS Gold Medal 1996
9. **'Prairie Charm'** Don Hollingsworth, 1992. Blossoms in shades of yellow with a hint of yellow-green. Centers are accented with dark red flares. Vigorous grower with abundant blossoming potential. Midseason.
