Enjoy a collection of treehouses, a playground, and several other structures all nestled along a quarter mile long trail loop through native woodland.

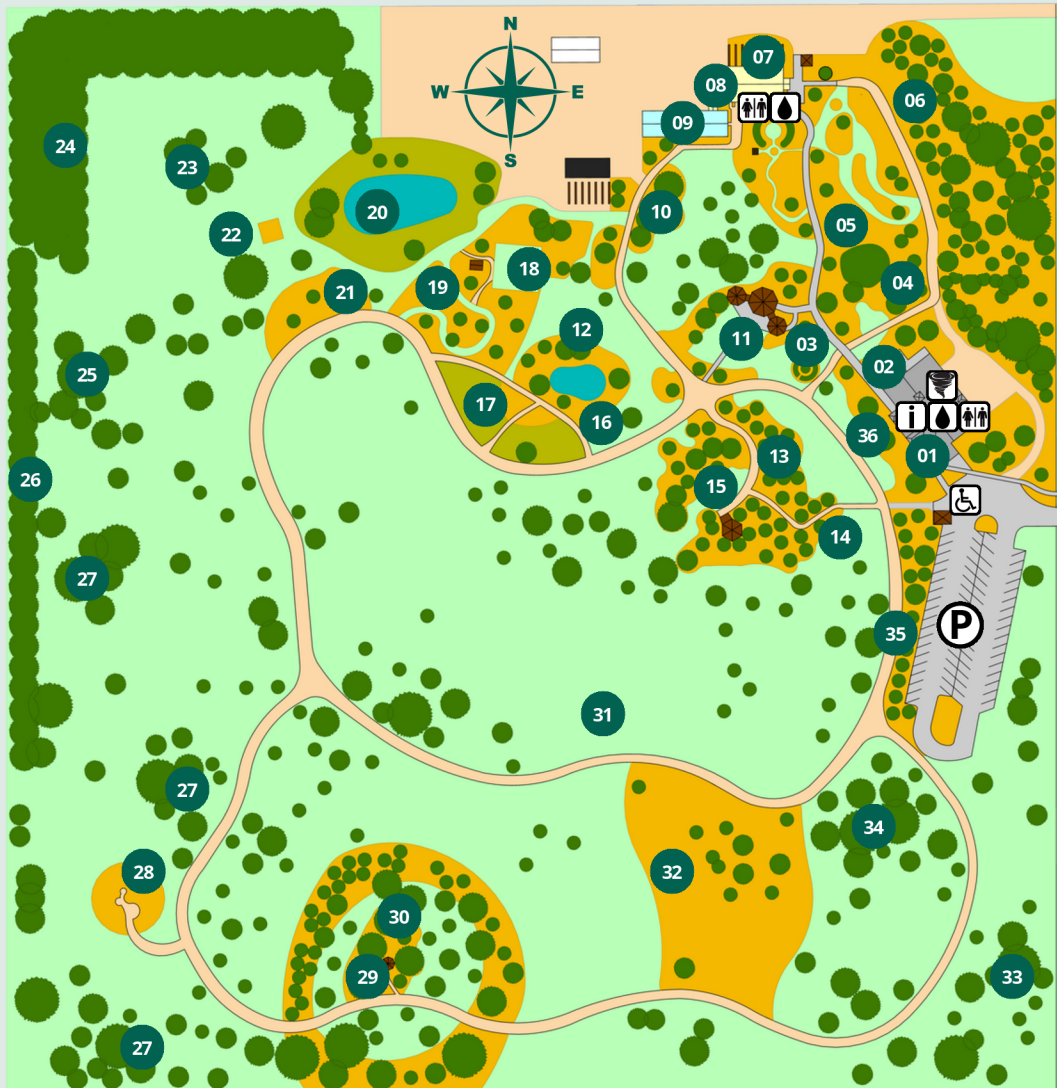

### 37 Prairie Restoration Trail\*

This quiet path follows the woodland edge around our 25 year old 4-acre prairie restoration. Great spot for bird or bug watching. Access from Peach Avenue. .33 miles easy

### 38 North Prairie Loop\* .4 miles easy

### 39 Herrick Memorial Trail\*

Let this out-and-back trail with 133 steps lead you down ravine slopes through native wildflowers and ferns to the Richardson Branch Creek. .25 miles difficult

### 40 Overlook Trail\*

This trail loop sticks to the upland edge through our 60 acre woods. Features scenic views of the wooded Richardson Branch Creek valley below. .5 miles easy

### 41 Walnut Trail\*

This trail loop meanders through level upland woodland. Excellent for viewing birds, butterflies, and summer wildflowers. .75 miles easy

### 42 South Prairie Loops\*

Explore 12 acres of prairie with great bird watching. .75 miles easy

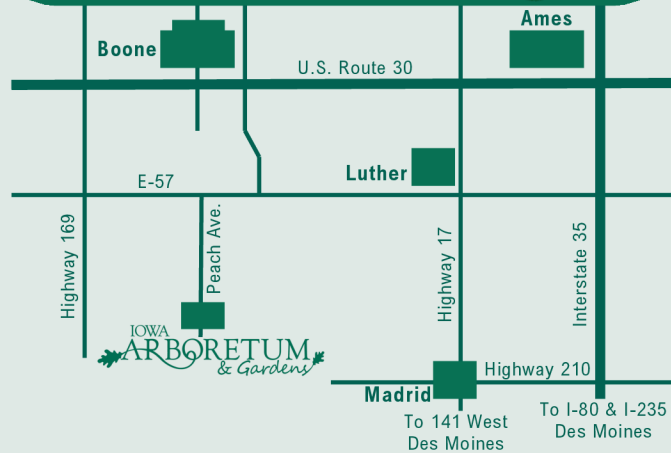
## WEDDINGS & FACILITY RENTALS
